Announcements & Events related to Transcom's priorities: MBHP is recruiting for its advisory council.

Update on survey development: The committee met to frame the task; a draft will be available next time. Clarified that we will not be inviting all who are surveyed and thus will need to make this clear in our outreach materials.

Preparation for meeting with Mass Rehabilitation Commission: Members shared experiences of MRCs current collaboration with DMH around ACCS and growth curve needed. In addition to these services, MRC's potential connection to Transcom is around its current role supporting the development of the healthcare workforce.
